Are you interested in having your children attend St. Ignatius Catholic School (SICS)

but worry that you might not be able to afford it?

Consider applying for SICS through the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program.

St. Ignatius Catholic School will be participating in the WPCP, (state voucher program), for 2019-20, which provides tuition for eligible students in the state who wish to attend a private school.

Who's Eligible?

Eligibility is determined by three factors: residency, income and where your student attended school in the previous year. Here's how to determine if your child may be eligible:

Previous Attendance

If your student already attends a private school he or she must be entering K4, kindergarten or 1st grade in 2019-20 to be eligible; If your student attended a public, virtual or charter school this year (2018-19) or is home-schooled, he or she may be eligible to apply for any grade, K4-8.

Residency

You will need to prove you reside in the state of Wisconsin.

Income

Eligibility is determined on a sliding scale that considers your family size and 2018 adjusted gross income. Below is a quick chart to consult. You will have to prove your income.

WPCP Income Limits - 220% of the Federal Poverty Level for 2019-20

Family Size	Maximum Yearly Income (Adjusted Gross Income)	
	Single Parent Household	Married Parent Household
2	\$36,212	\$43,212
3	\$45,716	\$52,716
4	\$55,220	\$62,220
5	\$64,724	\$71,724
6	\$74,228	\$81,228

For each additional member add \$9,504. A family whose parents are married can add another \$7,000 in additional income and still be eligible to apply.

APPLY IN JUST 2 EASY STEPS!

How to Apply:

If you think your child is eligible, we encourage you to consult with us about how to complete an acceptable application. WPCP application period begins February 1 and ends April 20. The program has a number limit set by the state. Applicants will learn whether they have been awarded a seat in late spring by the DPI. All online applications and documentation must be submitted to the DPI and school before the April 20 deadline. To schedule an appointment please call (920)759-9290.

1. Begin Online:

The application begins with an online form. You will need to create an account with the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) by using your email address and a password that you choose. Then, you must sign in using those credentials.

Follow the prompts to fill in the application. When you reach the income section, please choose the "DPI method" of income determination. We recommend, for various reasons, that you do not simply offer your Social Security number to determine eligibility. We also ask that you DO NOT SUBMIT your application. It will be in a queue holding for the next steps when you attend an application session or visit the school. We want to be certain that the documentation you are providing matches what you are submitting to the DPI online.

2. Bring Documentation:

Your application is not complete until you provide acceptable documentation to the school, preferably during our application sessions. Here's what you'll need:

Residency: the documentation you provide must have your formal name as used in the application along with the address you used on the application. Acceptable forms include: a utility bill (gas/electric/cable bill); government correspondence, W-2 statement or paycheck stub. All must be within a month or so of your application and have a date on it.

Income: use the DPI method and then provide one of the following: 2018 W-2s, 1040 federal income tax form for 2018, Soc. Sec. or SSI benefit statement for 2018. If you do not make enough to file taxes, bring a statement of your 2018 state benefits and child support for the year, which you can access online in most communities.
