The diocese presented a training in October of 2019 from Encounter Ministries. This is supported and encouraged by Bishop Ricken.

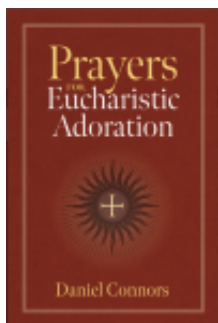
